A harmful consequences are systematically ignored by virtue of certain official and traditional considerations.

Due to the ever more frequent cases of death, we cannot claim that compulsory vaccination is a happy institution. The Philippines was the scene of three successive epidemics of smallpox, during which findings were as astonishing as they were remarkable. During the first, in 1905, ten percent of cases were fatal. Vaccination did not yet exist. — In 1906 the second took place and the number of deaths rose to thirteen percent. Vaccination was being introduced. — In 1908– 1909, vaccination having become widespread in the islands, mortality due to the third epidemic reached the proportion of 56%. These numbers can be verified in the report published by the Philippine Islands Health Authority.

Another example. We can see from United States government statistics that the epidemics that occurred in the country in 1902, 1908, and 1914 were caused by the vaccine itself. It is claimed that thousands of children subjected to compulsory vaccination were literally poisoned by the serum used, a misfortune the full extent of which was probably only measured a few years later.

It is high time that humanity opened its eyes. Fortunately, the signs of its awakening appear on the horizon. The masses are starting to think. Old theories are no longer accepted without examination. We verify, we compare and we reject what does not exist before reason.

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
